# THYRO-CAT MEDICAL HISTORY SHEET COMPLETELY FILLED OUT LABS:

- Ideally all labwork should be as current as possible in relation to the treatment date. We will accept any labs done within 3 months of the treatment date.
- If any of these labs have been done while on medication or Y/D diet (Tapazole/or diet trial) please include those for review.

#### 1) SUPERCHEM/CBC

2) URINALYSIS

#### 3) **T4 LEVEL**

- \*NOTE- T4 LEVELS MUST BE AN EXACT RESULT- IF DONE IN HOUSE THERE MUST BE A SPECIFIC READING (i.e.- >8 not acceptable).
- Any cat that has a serum T4 level in the gray zone (2.3-4.7 ug/dl) should have a fT4 submitted.
- Any cat that has been on thyroid medication or Y/D diet for over a 6 month period of time would need to have a T4 level taken once the cat has been off medication or diet for a week, included in pretesting. Each cat is given a individualized dose of I-131 based upon their T4 without influence of medication or diet.

### 4) RADIOGRAPHS:

Please send the actual radiographs of entire body VD and lateral views within the last 3 months. Also focus on area/s of concern.

\*\_For the cat's safety and the safety of the Thyro-Cat staff, have the cat's nails cut prior to treatment. If the cat is difficult to handle at the veterinary office, give the owner Gabapentin to be given the day of treatment. We reserve the right to refuse treatment to any cat whose owner does not comply with this policy.

IF TREATMENT IS DENIED, THE CLIENT WILL BE CHARGED THE COST OF THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND THE I-131 DRUG THAT WERE INCURRED IN PREPARATION FOR TREATING THE PET. \*
